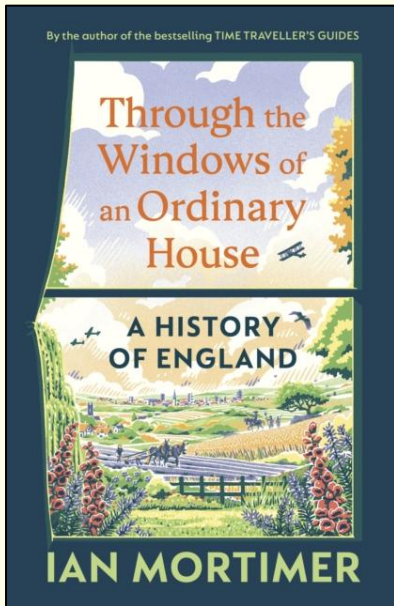


# Through the Windows of an Ordinary House
